White Bordeaux, however, offers an entirely different expression. Sauvignon Blanc, Sémillon, and Muscadelle come together in blends that can be bright and citrus-forward, or driven, layered, and textural.

Whether you're opening a classic château bottling or a fresh interpretation from a newer producer, expect a balance of history and craftsmanship that always feels relevant.
