### CHÂTEAU LA COTTE BORDEAUX 2018

Château La Clotte Bordeaux 2018 is a red wine from the Saint-Émilion Grand Cru appellation in France. It is a blend of 85% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 5% Cabernet Franc, resulting in a deep purple-black color and a complex bouquet of dark fruits, spices, smoke, and cedar. The wine has a full-bodied and rich palate, featuring firm tannins, juicy acidity, and a long finish. Château La Clotte Bordeaux is produced by Château La Clotte, a historic estate that dates back to the 12th century. This wine can be enjoyed with roasted meats, game, cheese, and mushroom dishes.

### CHÂTEAU DUCASSE GRAVES BLANC

Château Cérons Blanc is a versatile wine that can pair well with seafood, poultry, cheese, and salads.

### LA MEULIÈRE BORDEAUX 2020

La Meulière Bordeaux 2020 is a red wine from the Côtes de Bordeaux-Cadillac appellation in France. It is made from a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Cabernet Franc grapes that are grown on clay-limestone soils. The wine has a deep ruby color and aromas of ripe red fruits, spices, and vanilla. On the palate, it is full-bodied, balanced, and smooth, boasting fine tannins and a long finish. The wine is produced by Château de la Meulière, a family-owned estate that dates to the 17th century. La Meulière Bordeaux 2020 pairs well with grilled meats, cheese, pasta, and pizza. It can also be enjoyed on its own or with friends.
